

Pioneer Heritage Program

Learn about pioneer traditions and daily life. Sample pioneer food and enjoy other living history activities. Learn about a pioneer child's life on a farm and about grinding grains to make cornmeal and flour. We will help customize your Pioneer Heritage Program experience.

Grades: All

Length: 2 Hours

Scheduling: 2 weeks prior to arrival

Scavenger Hunt

The Scavenger Hunt takes you through the museum while you learn about life in the early days of the Smoky Valley. A staff member will give you a brief orientation before you begin. Students tour the exhibits with their teacher/adult sponsor in small groups and search for the answers to questions about life in the past.

Grades: 1-6

Length: 1 hr. 30mins.

Scheduling: 1 week prior to arrival

School House Program

Take your class back to 1903 in the one-room school house. We provide McGuffey readers, slates, desks, and lesson outlines. We also have old-fashioned toys and games for recess in the school yard. You choose the length of the program and **you** facilitate the activities for your students.

Grades: Elementary

Length: Varies– Teacher Choice

Scheduling: 1 week prior to arrival

This program is free to all schools

Mill Tours

Explore a guided tour of the Smoky Valley Roller Mill. Learn about the process and stages the wheat goes through to make flour.

Grades: All

Length: 30 Minutes

Scheduling: 2 weeks prior to arrival

Hoglund Dugout

Visit the Hoglund Dugout to see how early settlers solved the problem of shelter before they had lumber to build houses.

Grades: All

Length: 30mins.

Scheduling: 1 week prior to arrival

Enjoy your lunch on our picnic grounds adjacent to the museum along the Smoky Hill River or in the nearby park with playground equipment.
