**November 28, 2006**

**10:00 a.m. REGULAR MEETING**

Two items were added to the November 28, 2006 Agenda: 1) HOME Grant Award Update, 2) Work Session with KDHE. Commissioner Terry made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Patrick seconded. **All voted aye.**

No one spoke during Public Input at 10:00 a.m.

Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve the minutes for November 14, 2006. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve checks and claims for November 28, 2006. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve adds and abates, and landfill registers for November 24, 2006. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 10:10 a.m. Dianna Carter, County Appraiser, joined the meeting to request approval and signature on the end of probation Personnel Change Notice (PCN) for Denaye Dies, Review Field Appraiser I (10B), effective December 3, 2006. Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve and sign the PCN as presented. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Ms. Carter also noted that the Appraiser's Office is preparing for the final review of all County property for the 2007 valuation year. Appraiser's staff will be visiting all county properties in order to compare and verify property data.

Rick Witte, County Administrator, requested approval and signature on a Sheriff's Department PCN to hire Kim Peterson as part-time cook (4A), effective December 27, 2006. Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve and sign the PCN as presented. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Mr. Witte presented two (2) Notices to Township applications for cereal malt beverage licenses submitted by Prime Time Store #121, Inman, KS (Superior Township), and Rolling Acres Golf Club, McPherson, KS (New Gottland Township). Commissioner Patrick made a motion for the Chairman to sign the applications as presented. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 10:20 a.m. Mickey Stump, Community Corrections, joined the meeting to request approval and signature on the end of probation PCN for Carrie Sommerfeld, ISO I (S22B), effective November 17, 2006. Commissioner Patrick made a motion to approve and sign the PCN as presented. Commissioner Terry seconded. **All voted aye.**

Mr. Witte presented a letter from the Kansas Housing Resources Corporation notifying the Commissioners of the HOME Grant award to McPherson County in the amount of \$225,000. An additional five percent will also be granted for an administrative allowance. The grant funds are being provided through the federal HOME Investment Partnerships Program and will be used for funding local homeowner-occupied housing rehabilitation activities in McPherson County.

At 1:00 p.m. Commissioners recessed and reconvened at the Bank of America Building to attend a periodic review of the Local Environmental Protection Program by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment Watershed Management Section. No action was taken during the review. At 2:15 p.m. Commissioners recessed and reconvened at Public Works to continue the work session. At 3:40 p.m. Commissioner Terry made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Patrick seconded. **All voted aye.**
