THIRTEEN CASES OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) IDENTIFIED IN MCPHERSON COUNTY

McPherson County continues to hold at 13 total cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) at the time of this release.

The newest identified positive case is a Dillons employee who is recovering at home at this time. If you were in the McPherson Dillons store on March 31st, 2020 from 11:00 am to 9:00 pm or April 1st, 2020 from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, you may have been exposed to COVID-19. More information can be found on the Public Release from April 9th, 2020. At this time, nothing further will be released about the patient.

Please depend on health authorities to provide the most accurate information for McPherson County. If you are experiencing a fever, shortness of breath, or a cough, please call your health care provider. If you do not have a primary health care provider, please call your local hospital.
