### **CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) IN MCPHERSON COUNTY**

After carefully considering local hospital capacity, new case rates and provider feedback, MCHD recommends McPherson County transition to Phase 3 reopening plans beginning February 10, 2021. This decision will be reviewed March 9, 2021. Phase 3 limits gatherings to 45 individuals when 6-foot distance is not maintained. Phase 2 of the Kansas Vaccination Plan includes specific entities listed below and those 65+ years old. MCHD is not scheduling for later phases at this time, but you may email [machd@mcpersoncountyks.us](mailto:machd@mcpersoncountyks.us) with your contact information for future reference. MCHD is working with McPherson County IT to establish a registration portal for the vaccine that will automatically organize individuals by the Phase they belong in. This will streamline the registration and appointment process at MCHD. While federal supply prevents KDHE from supplying providers with vaccine, MCHD is also dividing our current shipments amongst 5 other county providers to help vaccinate the 65+ population. MCHD does not track how many doses are administered at locations outside of MCHD. Vaccine providers are required to report to three state and federal databases to account for doses administered. KDHE is working on adding cumulative data to their vaccine webpage, <https://www.kansasvaccine.gov/>. MCHD is also working on a dashboard layout for data that has been reported on cases, testing positivity rates, and vaccine. In the future, data updates that are included on the second page of these releases will be moved to the dashboard. Both IT developments are still in the works and a future public release will announce when they are both accessible.

As of this release, McPherson County is now working to vaccinate the 65+ population and Group B.

- Individuals 65+ years old should contact their primary care provider to be vaccinated. If you do not have a primary care provider, please call MCHD at 620-241-1753.
- Healthcare associated workers from Phase 1 will be able to receive vaccine in Phase 2 if they weren't vaccinated in Phase 1 shipments.
- Group A: K-12 staff, childcare providers, and disability service staff.
- Group B: Homeless shelters, higher education staff, USPS, and public transportation.
  - If you are 65+, you do not have to wait until Group B to be vaccinated.
- Group C: Food processing, agriculture, DMV, and public city and county offices.
  - If you are 65+, you do not have to wait until Group C to be vaccinated.

If you have questions about whether you should receive the vaccine or not, please discuss your concerns with your primary care provider. Vaccine supply comes in very small shipments so continued patience is appreciated. More information like dose counts can be found at <https://www.kansasvaccine.gov/>.

KDHE and MCHD continue to mandate a 10-day quarantine for Kansans if you have done any of the following:

- Traveled on or after February 26 to the countries of Mayotte, Czechia, San Marino, Montenegro, or Seychelles.
- Attended/traveled to a mass gathering event out-of-state of 500 people or greater where individuals did not 6-foot distance and wear masks
- Traveled on a cruise ship or river cruise
